By letter ref. GS/SSY/134/C/023, dated 7th February 2014, the Contractor notified the Project Manager that in terms of the provisions of clause 1210 of the contract specifications, works had been substantially completed and cordingly requested the Project Manager to issue a Certificate of Completion of Works. Following the joint inspection of the works conducted on 14th March 2014 with the Employer, the Contractor and the Consultant, the Project Manager hereby certifies completion of works on 7th February 2014.

In accordance with the Provisions of Clause 53.1, the Employer may formally take over the works within 7 days from the date of issuance of this certificate (i.e. by 8th April 2014). In accordance with the provisions of clause 33.1 of the Particular Conditions of Contract, the 12 months Defects Liability Period commenced on 8th February 2014 and will end on 7th February 2015.

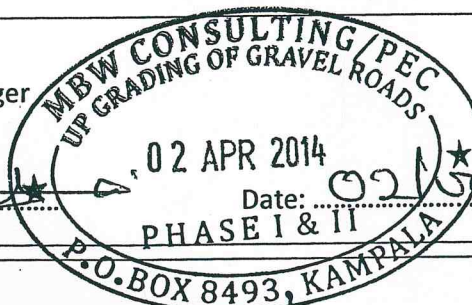
The description for the Works handed over by the Contractor in accordance with the contract is as follows: The upgrading from gravel road to bituminous surfaced road standard of Soweto road (1.23km) along with access roads junctions. The scope of works included drainage works comprising of the construction of culvert end structures to the triple 1200mm dia cross culvert at Ch 0+730, installation of 600mm dia precast concrete pipe culvert site drains under the raised sidewalks; including inspections manholes, cleaning up the site to remove any contamination of the works following the termination of the previous works contract, scraping off contaminated crushed stone sub-base / base material and disposing it off as agreed with the project manager, in-place re-working of the existing pavement layers; including importation of additional pavement material as deemed necessary, prime coat application to the CRR base, construction of 50mm asphalt surfacing on the carriageway and 30mm asphalt surfacing on the raised sidewalks, street lighting works, road signs installation and road markings as well as installation of speed control rumble strips and humps at designated locations.

Outstanding Work and Defects

The outstanding works to be completed by 11th April 2014 includes testing and commissioning of the street lighting, replacement of some damaged manhole covers, some minor finishing works around manhole covers, complete clean up of the site, painting of the raised pedestrian crossings, and some stone pitching works upstream and downstream of the cross culvert at Ch 0+730. Details of these outstanding works are included in the attached snag list.
